Who we are

What data we process and why

The British Indian Ocean Territory Administration carries out the day-to-day running of the British Indian Ocean Territory. In doing so we process personal data including passport and insurance information.

We will ensure that we will treat all relevant personal information in accordance with best data protection practice.

Legal basis for the processing

We process this data because it is necessary to do so in order to perform our official functions as the Government of the British Indian Ocean Territory.

What we do with it

Your data will be stored securely by the British Indian Ocean Territory Administration. There may be circumstances in which we may lawfully share your data with third parties where, for example, we are required to do so by law, by court order, or to prevent fraud or other crimes. Where we share data, however, we shall do so in accordance with best data protection practice.

How long we keep your data

We will retain your personal data for only as long as it is necessary or for as long as we are legally required to do so and in line with our Retention Schedule. For example, details of suppliers and details of permits issued must be retained for ten years as they form part of accounts documentation. Outside of the details required for permits other personal information supplied as part of science expeditions and other travel will normally only be kept until the activity is complete.

Your rights

You have the right to:

- Object request that your data is not processed for certain purposes.
- <u>Erasure</u> request that your personal data is erased where one of the statutory grounds applies
- <u>Data portability</u> the right to obtain and reuse your personal data for your own purposes across different services in certain circumstances.
- <u>Restrict processing</u> request that the processing of your personal data is restricted in certain circumstances – for example, where accuracy is contested.
- <u>Rectification</u> request that any inaccuracies in your personal data are rectified without delay. Request that any incomplete personal data is completed, including by means of a supplementary statement.
- Access request information about how your personal data is processed and to request a copy of that personal data.

If your personal data is processed on the basis of consent, you have the right to:

- withdraw consent to the processing of your personal data at any time.
- request a copy of any personal data you have provided.
