RRBIOT c.I.4.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 5 of the Trade in Endangered Species (Control) Ordinance 2001, the Commissioner has appointed –

- 1. The Joint Nature Conservation Committee to act as Scientific Authority in respect of fauna; and
- 2. The Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, to act as Scientific Authority in respect of flora,

under that Ordinance and for the purposes of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES).
